# **Current Status of "Sharing City Seoul" Projects**

# ■ Development of infrastructure of "Sharing City"

- o "Sharing City Seoul" declared on September 20, 2012
  - "Car Sharing" and other priority projects selected, sharing city infrastructure developed and propagated
- Seoul Metropolitan City ordinance for sharing enacted on December 31, 2012
  - Sharing organizations and businesses designated, administrative and financial support provided, Sharing Promotion Committee organized and operated
- Sharing Promotion Committee organized and operated under joint private sector-government governance
  - Total of 15 members: 2 from the City Council, 12 civilian experts, 1 government employee
  - Determines the designation of sharing organizations or businesses, support for project funding; reviews or advises on policies for promoting sharing
- Seoul Metropolitan City ordinance enforcement rules for sharing enacted on February 21, 2013
- "Seoul Sharing Hub" operation supported

Information	Production, accumulation archiving, dissemination
Plaza	promotion, and provision of information
Network Forum	Support for formation or link with sharing-related organizations, businesses, media, or social sectors
Campaigns	Campaigns waged to diffuse sharing
Education	Education or training of venture startups, interested citizens, and government employees

### Support for sharing organizations or businesses

- The city government designates "sharing organizations" or "sharing businesses."
  - Eligibility: Organizations or businesses wishing to resolve social problems through sharing
  - Application method: Applications accepted on the Internet during the public recruitment held two to three times a year
  - Status of designation: 42 organizations or businesses
  - Effects or benefits: Designation certificate issued, Sharing Seoul Brand Image license granted, administrative and financial support

### • Administrative and financial support to sharing organizations or businesses

- Administrative support: Support for collaboration with related government departments, networking with other sharing organizations or businesses, and improvement of institutions or systems
- Financial support: Financial support provided to projects with greater sharing promotion effects among those implemented by the designated organizations or businesses

### Support for the startup of sharing economy business

- 20 teams selected based on '1,000 projects or tasks designated for Youth Business Startup Incubation'
- Provides office space, operational funds, support for training or consulting

### Outcome of support to sharing organizations and businesses in 2013

- Total amount of project funds supported: 286 million won to 18 businesses and organizations
- Parking lot sharing : 0 parking lot → 359 parking lots (Yongsan-gu)
- Home stay in city:  $4,000 \text{ rooms} \rightarrow 6,700 \text{ rooms} \pmod{5,100 \text{ to } 13,500}$
- Sharing of kids' clothing: Total clothes held 17,894 pieces → 40,235 pieces

  Total exchange cases 1,527 → 3,458
- Sharing of performance props: 100% increases in successful cases and memberships

- Areas for promoting sharing: Sharing cars, talents, food, or kids' clothing
- Methods for promoting sharing: Joint promotion by the city government, sharing hub, and sharing organizations or businesses

### • "Tomorrow is designed by reviewing experiences in sharing city programs in 2013"

- Period/Venue: Youth Job Hub, 2013.12.23
- Sharing experiences of sharing programs by sharing organizations or businesses in 2013 to seek program directions for 2014

### o "Sharing Imagining Workshop" held

- Period/Venue: Seoul Partners House, 2014.01.27
- Attended by government employees, members of sharing organizations or businesses, members of the Sharing Promotion Committee, etc.
- Policies developed for "Sharing City Seoul," which can be implemented through collaboration between the private and public sectors

## ■ Leading Sharing City Seoul projects as of April 2014

#### Car sharing(Nanum car)

- Cars shared conveniently as required anytime, anywhere, hourly rates paid
- Implemented by: Green Point Consortium Ltd., So-Car Ltd., etc.
- Sharing record: 282,356 members' service used

A total of 1,070 cars held for sharing

### Parking lot sharing

- Support provided to organizations, businesses, and autonomous district offices wishing to resolve parking lot shortage by sharing parking lots
- Sharing record: Pilot areas have been selected in Yongsan-gu and Songpa-gu for sharing all parking lots in the districts.

#### 359 parking lots secured (Yongsan-gu)

- Implementation plan: Plans to diffuse the service to more autonomous districts, including sharing for-residents-only parking lots in Gwangjingu and parking lots of apartment houses in Seongbuk-gu.

#### Shared bookshelves

- Sharing books with neighbors by storing them on shared bookshelves
- Sharing record: 19 bookshelves opened

#### • Sharing idle space in public or government-owned facilities

- Opening conference rooms and auditoriums at government buildings for use by citizens
- Sharing record: 970pieces of idle space fully opened and used in 22,931 cases

### Room Sharing

- Senior citizens as landlords share their extra rooms with students at low rent, with the students helping their landlords in life, including chatting companion service.
- Sharing record: 28 students at 23 households in Nowon-gu and Gwangjin-gu
- Implementation plan: Scheduled to diffuse the service in Seodaemun-gu, etc.

#### Children's Clothes Sharing Program

- Parents can purchase their kids' clothing using the credit points they earn by donating used kids' clothing to sharing businesses.
- The program is being promoted by signing an MOU between the autonomous district offices and Federation of Nursing Homes Operated by the Central and Local Governments.
  - Sharing record: 31,246 cases of exchange of kids' clothing through Kiple Ltd., a designated sharing business

#### Seoul e-Sharing(e-Poomasi)

- Sharing goods, talents, or services using regional community currency
- Sharing record: 21,052 cases by 5,685 people in 15 districts

#### Open Data Plaza

- Public data with high social or economic values opened to citizens
- Documents signed by section supervisors or higher government officials fully disclosed to citizens
- Sharing record: 1,300 data sets on 125 systems opened

## Status of improvement of statutes and institutions obstructing sharing

### Status and problems

- Too stringent requirements for sharing empty rooms with tourists
- Tourist interpreting guide certificate is mandatory for guiding foreign tourists.
- When religious facilities are shared, their benefit of tax exemption may be revoked.

#### o Progress

- Legislation is planned by drawing social consensus through panel discussion by experts.
- The improvement of statutes or institutions obstructing sharing has been recommended to the central government.
- The Seoul Metropolitan Government is currently consulting with insurance carriers to develop insurance that can indemnify damages suffered by users of sharing services.

### [Statutory provisions obstructing sharing activities]

- Regulations on Standards for Urban Home Stay Service for Foreign Tourists, Enforcement Rules of the Tourism Promotion Act
  - The total floor area shall be less than 230 m<sup>2</sup>.
  - The applicant or household member must be able to provide foreign language service.
- Problematic provisions related to the sharing of travel experiences in the Tourism Promotion Act
  - Travel service providers shall employ those who have acquired Tourist Interpreting Guide Certificate for providing tourism guide service to foreign tourists.
- Problematic provision on taxation when religious facilities are shared in the Act on Restricting Exemption from Local Taxes
  - Taxes are not waived when religious facilities are used for profit-seeking services or when they are not used directly for their mission or purpose.
- Provision related to the sharing of privately owned cars in the Passenger
   Transport Service Act
  - Renting non-business cars for consideration is prohibited.
