Seoul Human Resource Development Center (SHRDC) shares Seoul's urban policy and experience with urban leaders in the world

SHRDC (Seoul Human Resources Development Center) of Seoul Metropolitan Government (SMG) has been contributing to solving global urban issues by sharing Seoul's urban policies through international training programs. The Center invites foreign city officials to 5-10 day international programs including lectures, site visits, policy presentations from foreign cities, and interactive discussions. The themes of training programs are related to the urban development issues and challenges rising around the world, including but not limited to smart city, sustainable mobility and climate change. However, due to the outbreak of the COVID-19, the center temporarily suspended invitation-based offline international programs and conducted three pilot online training programs on smart city and HRD.

In 2021, based on the experience of providing trial online training programs in 2020, SHRDC will continue to provide international training programs via online platform. 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Background

Seoul Metropolitan Government established a training academy at SHRDC to share the Seoul's best urban polices with foreign officials to support sustainable urban development of foreign local governments. Since 2008, SHRDC has been conducting international training programs and the center invited more than 2,200 foreign officials to share the knowledge and expertise in regards to various urban fields through more than 150 international training programs and events.

However, due to the outbreak of the COVID-19, the center temporarily suspended invitation-based offline international training programs. In 2021, SHRDC will provide international training programs via online to continuously contribute to the urban development of the cities and local governments around the world.

Outline

In 2020, with the suspension of the invitation-based offline international training programs, the center implemented three pilot online training programs. Based on the experience of providing trial online training programs, SHRDC consulted with its partner organizations as well as selected foreign cities and local governments to plan 10 online training programs to be offered for foreign officials in 2021.

SHRDC online training is based on the Self-Paced e-Learning with Assignment Submission.

All training participants are expected to conduct Self-Paced e-Learning of three pre-recorded online lectures during three weeks on SHRDC MOOC platform and submit designated assignments such as "Action Plan" and conduct "Quiz" prior to the agreed deadline.

However, with the request from the partner organizations or foreign cities, "Real-time Live Session" can be added to the online program. All participants are requested to pass the evaluation criteria for the issuance of the official SHRDC certificate upon the completion.

| Program Evaluation | Participants are required to submit the quiz, essay, action plan and photos by each designated deadline. SHRDC evaluates the submissions and issues certificates to the qualified participants. |
| Program Coordination | ◆ Application for the online training shall be done 6 weeks prior to the opening of the program. Those interested in the training program are encouraged to submit the official SHRDC application form. ◆ A representative of the participating cities or partner organizations shall consult with SHRDC staff for the details of designing and delivery of the online training program upon the submission of participants' application form to SHRDC. ◆ A representative of the participating cities or partner organizations shall consult the roles of responsibilities and the cost for the online training at the initial coordination phase. |



Program Design and Delivery Flow

Online training program requires more preparation time compared to invitation-based offline training program due to the production of e-learning content. For this reason, SHRDC's initial consultation with participating cities & partner institutions will take place 90 days prior to the starting date of the actual online training program. Therefore, the participating cities need to timely provide confirmed lists of minimum 15 participants with required application forms to SHRDC for the effective design and delivery of online training program contents.

A participating city or partner organization shall consult with SHRDC staff for the details of designing and delivery of the online training programs.

SHRDC will design online training based on the needs analysis from the participating cities and coordinate the e-learning contents and evaluation guidelines. If necessary, Real-time Live Session can be arranged & prepared.

SHRDC will create a dedicated online classroom for the trial test at SHRDC MOOC platform. SHRDC will also provide a guidebook for the program.

Self-Paced e-Learning with Assignment Submission; All training participants are expected to conduct Self-Paced e-Learning of 3 lectures during aforementioned period and are requested to submit designated assignments prior to the 18th Sep.

♦ Evaluation

All submitted assignments are subjected to PASS/FAIL evaluation by the lecturers for issuing the certificate of completion.





Who can participate in SHRDC Online Training Program?

- ◆ A foreign public official from the selected cities (or local government) in a related field to the theme of online training with the internet access capability for online training programs. * Please contact SHRDC for your city's or local government's eligibility in 2021.
- ◆ A foreign public official recommended by the head (such as mayor) of his/her city or local government and who has submitted application forms for the training to SHRDC.
- ◆ A foreign public official with a good command of English (*For English Program Only).
- ◆ A foreign public official who has never participated in training programs organized by both Seoul Metropolitan Government(SMG) & SMG affiliated organizations for the last 5 years. * Exceptions may apply.

What are the themes of SHRDC Online Training Program?

◆ URBAN RESILIENCE Policy Online Training Program

Urban resilience is the measurable ability of any urban system, with its inhabitants, to maintain continuity through all shocks and stresses, while positively adapting and transforming toward sustainability. * Seoul's best practices and policies to strengthen resilience against disasters as well as sustainable city development will be covered in online lectures. Participants will be able to share the best practices for strengthening urban resilience in global cities and understand the importance of governance, citizen-participation and global partnerships for city resilience.




