

Expected Benefits

- Create a platform for interactive communication with citizens
 - Build an open platform where citizens, government, and public employees can all participate and communicate
 - Realize a consensus-based communication by engaging citizens in making decisions on administrative tasks
 - Applicable to the entire process of policymaking from policy setting, determination, and execution to policy evaluation
 - Directly reflect the opinions of citizens at policy-making conferences
- Boost the participation of citizens across the society
 - Make a shift from a government-led decision making to a citizen-engaging decision making
 - Go beyond the participatory atmosphere in organizations and spread the culture of citizen-centered living in daily lives.
